



In 2024, What % of Students Met/Exceeded Expectations in Math








In 2024, how did Wandell's Average Score Compare to NJ Average Scores in Math?















In 2024, what is the performance breakdown in Science?









Trends in Consecutive Data


WANDELL ELA DATA TRENDS

2024-25 Actions

- Continued Departmentalization of Grade 4 & 5 (ELA, Math and Science)
- Increased support in Grade 5 Math for all students with additional staff
- Continued PD in Conquer Math for all teachers including this year including Special Education teachers
- Continued use of iReady Universal Assessment - Additional PD for all staff members in September 2024 to increase effectiveness
- Articulation for staff to increase vertical discussion and lesson development - includes weekly curriculum and data review with colleagues and administration
- Science Specialist as part of the state articulation committee for NJSLA question formation - new science program Elevate Science
- Maximizing staff scheduling opportunities for year long NJSLA instruction in Math and ELA - with simulated lessons using instructional software, Lumos and released NJDOE exemplars

2024-25 Actions

- Curriculum updates in alignment to new State Standards ELA and Math
- Piloting new math program with 2nd grade
- Curriculum writing/unit opportunities with Ramsey and neighboring districts to build capacity including special education staff
- Orton Training for all staff - including Morphology here this year
- Additional Enrichment Opportunities with Imagineers, Entrepreneur (Treds) and Drama, Wandell TV Station, Broadcasts
- Increased Gifted and Talented competitions and participation
- Increase RTI/EIS sections for all grades in ELA/Math
- Continuous Student Profile Data Analysis to Monitor Student Performance including Benchmark and Diagnostic Adaptive Assessments (IXL) - in ELA, Math & Science
